# **Next up: Union Station**

Exciting things are happening downtown with RTD's FasTracks program. The Union Station bus facility is 93 percent complete and set to open on May 9, 2014. The new 22-bay bus facility will replace Market Street Station. The renovation of the historic building into a boutique hotel with restaurants and retail is 89 percent complete, and will open in the summer of 2014.

Once fully developed, Union Station will serve as a mixed-use transit hub, providing bus, light rail, commuter rail service as well as the return of Amtrak. Watch for updates on <u>Union Station.</u>
