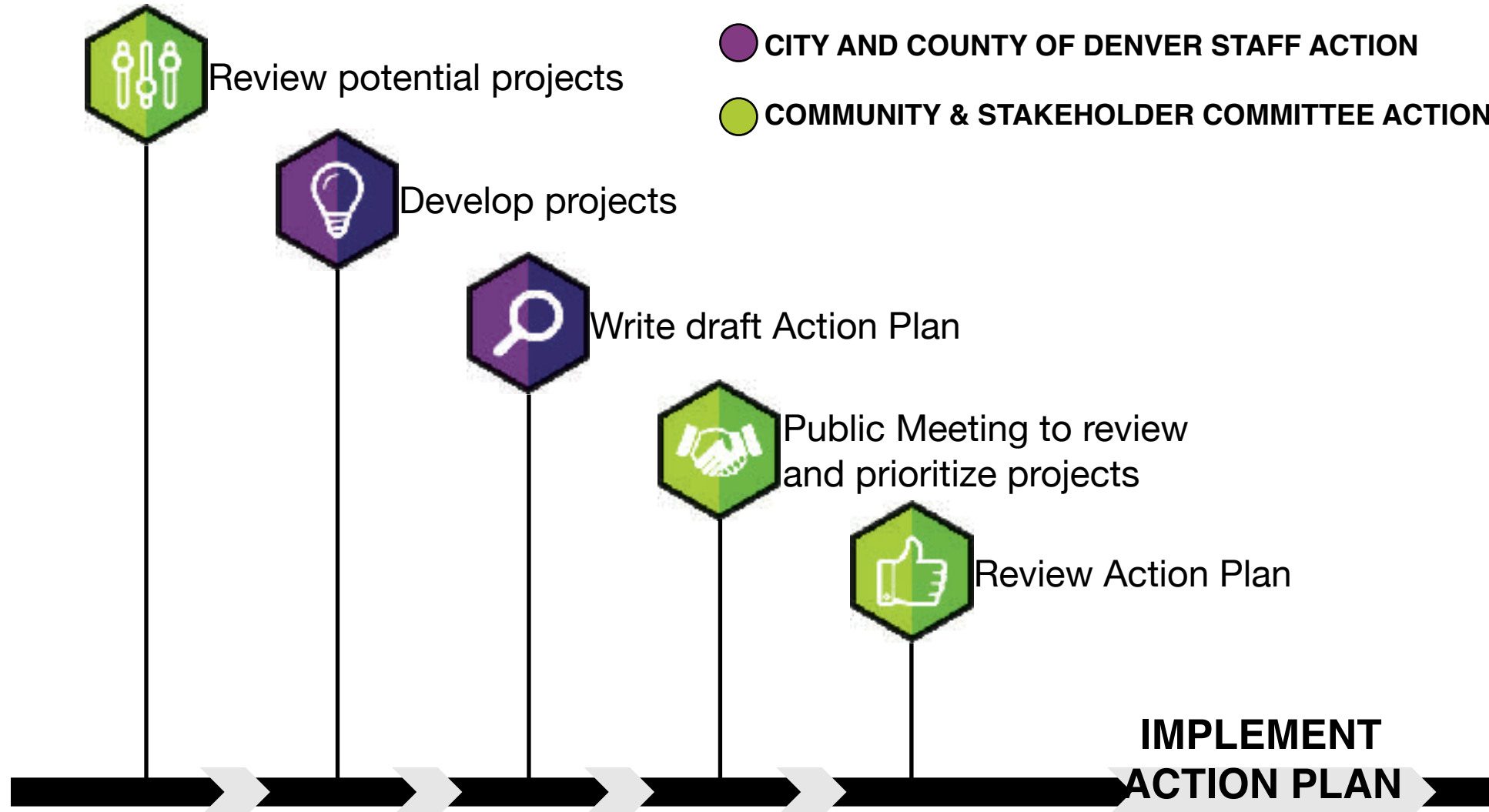
The NTMP Five Points Action Plan will identify **5 to 15 near-term transportation & mobility enhancement projects**, while highlighting longer term actions.



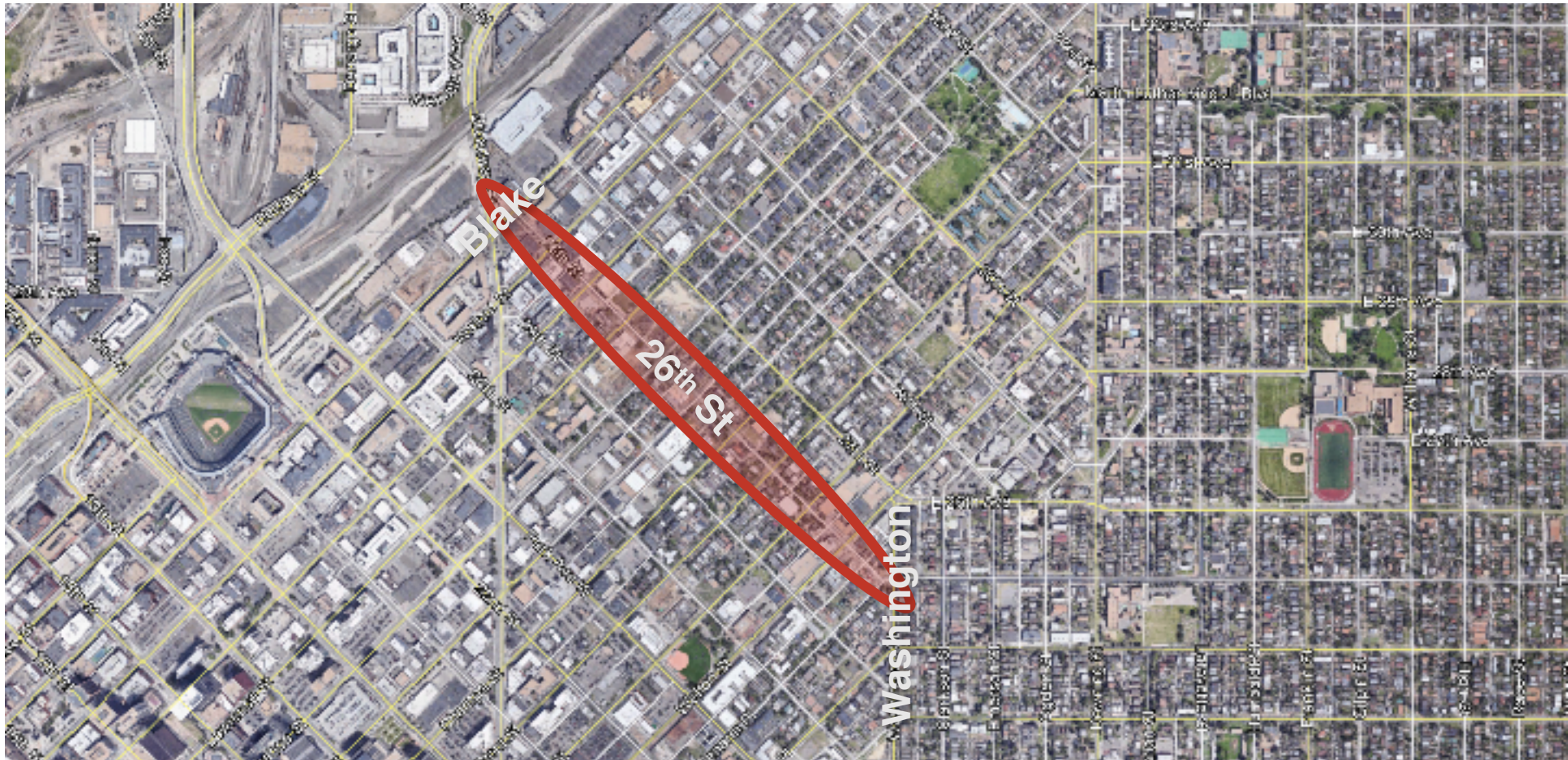

CONSTRUCTION INSPECTIONS

Our **Inspections Team** performs construction inspections of Right-of-Way and Wastewater improvements for privately funded projects and other projects not funded by Public Works. We review and inspect uses, facilities and construction within the public right-of-way of the City and County of Denver.



Ensure that all construction of sanitary sewers and storm sewers meet per the City's policies and standards to avoid flooding, erosion and create sanitary water conditions.



Make certain that right-of-way is constructed in a way that is safe and beneficial for the public, and accommodates all modes of transportation.

CONSTRUCTION PERMITTING

Our **Permitting Operations** is the point of contact for obtaining right of way permits for street closures, block parties, special events, temporary signs, street furniture, pushcarts and parking.



All Public Works Permits for the right-of-way can be applied and paid for on the City of Denver website



Permitting Operations offers over 45 permits online and completed over 60,000 permits for the right of way in 2017.
